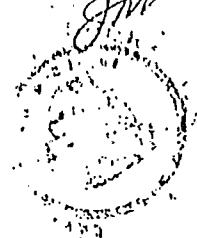

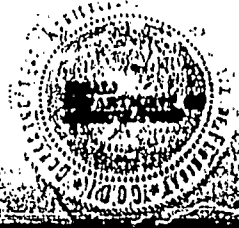

FOR
HARRY T. MOORE**

Biographical Notes for Harry T. Moore

- 1868** In 1868 +/- George Warren moves to Brevard County with his with and children.
- 1870** In 1870 the federal census lists George Warren as a white man with a mulatto wife and children. The census also reports that his wife was born in Virginia while he and all but his youngest children were born in Georgia and that he is employed as a farmer.
- 1880** In 1880 the federal census lists George Warren and his entire family as mulatto

The men who challenged the injustices and racism faced by blacks and who encouraged blacks to do the some often lost their jobs or were even beaten or killed, like NAACP president Harry T. Moore.¹

- 1891** 12 year old Annie Warren [who subsequently married David Sims] inherits a share of George Warren estate [her late father] including the following described property:
09-05-1891 - Public Records of Brevard County:

This Indenture made the 5th day of September AD 1891 Between Thomas Warren and his wife Maggie Warren of Brevard County Florida Parties of the first part and S.C.T. Warren, Joseph Warren, Valerie Ann Curry, Annie Ann Warren and Ada Eugene Curry, Parties of the Second Part. Witness that the Said Parties of the First Part for and in consideration of the Sum of Five Dollars Lawful Money of the United States of America to them in hand Paid by the Said Parties of the Second Part the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for and in consideration of Certain conveyance to be hereafter made by S.C.T. Warren, Joseph Warren and Valerie Ann Curry to five acres and two sevenths undivided interest in a certain lot in the town of Titusville have [?] remised [?], released and quit claimed and by these presents do remise, release and quit claim unto the Said parties of the Second Part and to their heirs and assigns forever all this interest right title claim and demand whatsoever to all those pieces and parcels or tracts of Land lying and being in the County of Brevard and State of Florida to wit: To each of the Parties of the Second Part is hereby conveyed according to this respective rights, titles and interests under a certain Decree of Partition made on the 18th day of April A.D. 1891 in the Circuit Court of the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida in and for Brevard County on a Partition of the Lands of the estate of George Warren Late of Said County deceased among the said parties of the Second Part as heirs at law of Said George Warren Deceased and Said land being described as follows to wit:

(7) acres in the South half of the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section (20) twenty of Township (21) twenty one South of Range (35) thirty five East described as follows beginning in the center of Said Section thence run west (304) Three hundred and four yards to Public Road; thence north 110 yards; thence East 304 yards to the dividing line, thence south 110 yards to the Place of beginning; Also (10) ten acres in the same Section Township, and Range described as follows: the NE1/4 of the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Said Township, Section and Range, Also (8) Eight acres described as follows commencing 110 yards South of the NW Corner of the SW1/4 of

- 1926** Harriett and Harry T. Moore marry.
- 1931** Annie Sims and David Sims sell to Harriet Moore and Harry Moore, her husband: Beginning at the North East (NE) Corner of the North East Quarter (NE¼) of the South West Quarter (SW¼) of the North West Quarter (NW¼) of Section Twenty (20) Township Twenty-One (21) South, Range Thirty-Five (35) East, thence go West 132 feet; thence South 330 feet; thence East 132 feet; thence North 330 feet to point of beginning, containing One (1) acre more or less.³
- 1934** "In Brevard County, young schoolteacher Harry Moore was placed under Klan surveillance after he launched a local chapter of the NAACP in 1934. The following year, a member of Moore's group was beaten to death by a white man, supposedly while trying to collect a debt. Black witnesses to the murder refused to testify before a grand jury, and the case was dropped. A white attorney hired by Moore to investigate, reported back that the witnesses had been threatened and that local lawmen were unwilling to pursue the case."⁴
- 1943** Harry Melvin Curry, Single sells to Harry Moore and Harriette Moore, his wife: S½ of NE¼ of SW¼ of SW¼ of Section 20, Tp. 21 S., R. 35 East, containing 5 acres, more or less.⁵
- 1949** Harry T. Moore formed the Florida Progressive Voters League to encourage blacks to register [to vote]. Between 1947 and 1950, the number of blacks enrolled on the suffrage lists swelled from 49,000 to more than 116,000.⁶ Moore also served as president of the stated conference of NAACP branches, and he initiated judicial action to equalize the salaries of underpaid black school teachers with those of whites. For his activities, he and his wife were fired from their teaching positions in Brevard County.
