Inc. and or Dudco Inc. did unlawfully and feloniously engage in a scheme to defraud, to-wit: a systematic, ongoing course of conduct which involved land sales presentations and the subsequent sale of land, with intent to defraud one or more persons, to-wit: Eliades Carbonell; and/or Teresita Carbonell; and/or Isern
