Dear Senator Baucus:

I am writing to request your consideration of legislation to exempt from income taxation payments made to Florida persons, from BP, due to the Deepwater Horizon oil spill for calendar year 2010. Exempting these payments from federal income tax would supplement the relief now being considered under the proposed Gulf Coast Oil Spill Loss Carryback amendment. It is critical that Florida's fishermen, shrimpers and other affected persons be able to utilize the oil spill compensation to the fullest extent.

Along with eliminating a *federal* tax burden, the *Florida* corporate income tax on those payments would automatically be waived as it is based on federal taxable income. This would be double relief for those corporations subject to Florida corporate income tax who are adversely affected by the oil spill. By providing a federal tax benefit, the proposed legislation would help all adversely affected Floridians to feed their families, make their mortgage payments, and sustain themselves while their livelihood is at risk due to the oil spill.
