What is the Community Resource Exhibition?

The 2016 Florida Human Trafficking Summit will host a Community Resource Exhibition where anti-trafficking organizations can promote their work and resources with Summit attendees.

When is the Community Resource Exhibition?

The Community Resource Exhibition will officially take place at the Summit from **8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** on **Monday, October 10, 2016**, at the Rosen Centre Hotel in Orlando. **Please ensure your table is staffed at all times during the Summit.** Vendor set-up will begin at **7:30 a.m.** on Monday and **ALL** vendor booths must be broken down by **5:00 p.m.**

What will it cost to have a table?

The cost to exhibit will be \$50.00 and checks should be made payable to: **Florida Juvenile Justice Foundation (FEID NO.59-3623272)**. The Summit will provide a 6-foot table and skirting at no cost to you. Your organization is responsible for bringing promotional materials and ensuring you have a representative present at the table for the entirety of the Summit.

What criteria will be used to determine who gets a table?

Due to space limitations, the Summit will not be able to provide tables for all organizations seeking to participate in the Community Resource Exhibition. The Summit will select applicants based on the following criteria:

- Extent and quality of the anti-trafficking work done by the organization
- Uniqueness of the work done by the organization
- Area(s) of Florida where organization conducts work
