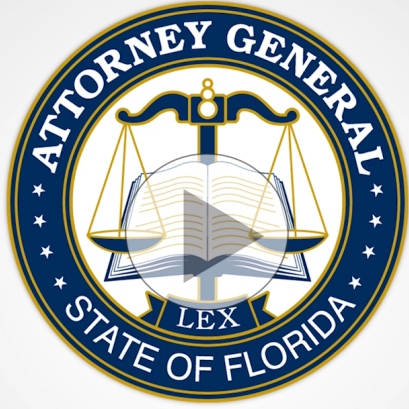
Attorney General Moody Secures 55-Year Sentence for Violent Human Trafficker Who Branded Victim
